

## **ELIGIBILITY**

- 1. Must be a graduate of an accredited high school or vocational school.
- 2. Applicants must have been accepted for admission by an accredited four year or two years educational or vocational institution.
- 3. Applicants must have demonstrated scholarship ability, leadership qualities and involvement in student or community activities.
- 4. All applicants must apply for Federal PELL Grant and if Pennsylvania resident, must also apply for PA State Grant (PHEAA). These forms are available through your school's financial aid office and online. Applicant must be able to justify financial need.
- 5. Scholarships are open to any individual whose parent or guardian is involved in the outdoor amusement industry, or is involved in the outdoor amusement industry, him or herself.

## APPLICATION PROCEDURE

- 1. To apply, you must complete Sections I and III and return to the Scholarship Committee prior to June 30, 2026.
- 2. The Scholarship Committee will make and announce their decisions sometime during the fall semester and scholarships will be applied to tuition for the spring semester.
- 3. These awards are for one year only and any recipient is eligible for reapplication in succeeding years.
- 4. All grants will be forwarded directly to the appropriate institution in the name of the recipient.
